

SAFER ROAD USE

From 1 January 2007 a number of road rule changes will come into force targeted at improving our road safety culture and saving lives on our roads.



From 1 January 2007

PENALTIES WILL INCREASE

Fines will double for drink driving, speeding, running red lights, not wearing seatbelts, not displaying L or P plates.

NEW SPEED LIMITS WILL COMMENCE

130 km/h speed limits will apply on the Stuart, Barkly, Victoria and Arnhem Highways. A new default 110 km/h limit will apply on all other rural roads unless otherwise signposted.

COMPULSORY CHILD RESTRAINTS WILL APPLY

All children under 1 must be restrained in an appropriate capsule or baby seat when travelling in vehicles.
