

Drugs, driving and the law



From 1 July 2008, NT Police have the power to conduct roadside saliva screen tests.

These tests will allow the detection of prohibited drugs at crashes or unexplained driving behaviour, which are not related to the consumption of alcohol.

NT Police will also be conducting random saliva tests for drugs in drivers of all heavy vehicles over 4.5 tonnes gross vehicle mass.

Drug driving is as dangerous as drink driving.
